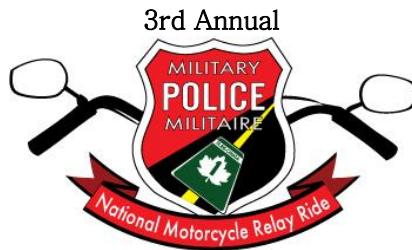

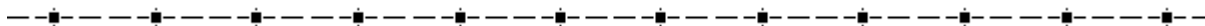

Park Fees:

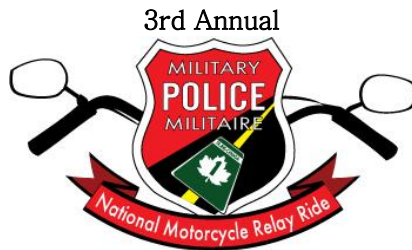

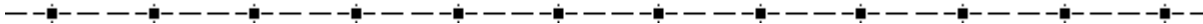
